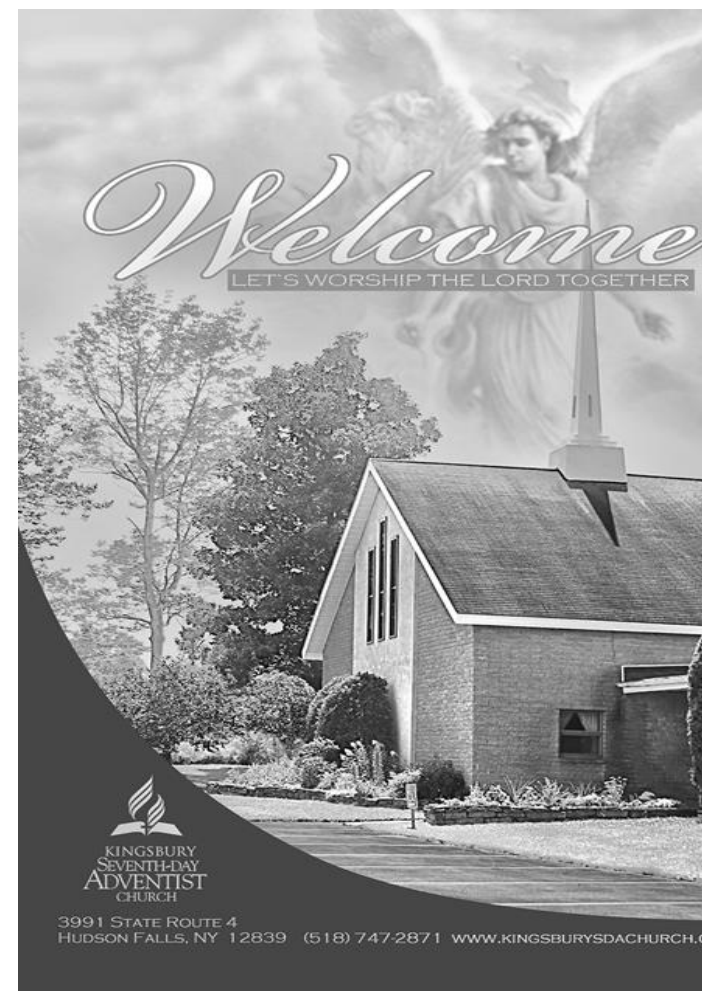

Refuge in the Lord
When we come to the God of the Bible
Psalms 141:3,4 Set a guard, O Lord,
over my mouth; keep watch over the
door of my lips! Do not let my heart
incline to any evil, to busy myself with
wicked deeds in company with men who
work iniquity, and let me not eat of their
delicacies!

Left to ourselves, it is impossible to overlook an insult, a misunderstanding, an accusation. Only one healthy way forward exists: "My eyes are toward you, O God, my Lord; in you I seek refuge"(vs 8). David pulls his attention off his accusers and puts them on the Lord. What this means is to trust God himself to vindicate us in his own good way and time. We can look to God only to the degree that we remember that we ourselves deserve God's punishment and judgement that Jesus absorbed in our place.
